

Update from the Committee


Welcome to all new members as well as those returning for a new season from your committee. To ensure club members receive an understanding of what is going on in the club's background, the committee will create these short monthly updates.

Fixtures and Results

You'll play the other 3 teams in your league. And then play horizontally against the teams that finished in the same place. Eg A1 (the team that comes top in A), B2, C1 will be in a league. A2, B1, C2 will be in a different league. That will form the Cup, and then the same thing for the Finally there will be a play-off to determine final finishing position. In total, there will be 6 games per team. Shotclocks will be in use throughout the day.
